Tidbinbilla Nature Reserve Tour

Time: 10:30am Saturday

Duration: 6 hours approx.
Grade: Medium

Nestled on the edge of Namadgi National Park, Tidbinbilla Nature Reserve is home to a multitude of native animals including wallabies, emus, echidnas, koalas and platypus.

On this tour, we cycle along the Reserve's 35kph 16 kilometre sealed loop road, stopping along the way to soak in the views and observe the native flora and fauna. We'll take a walk to see the bird life and maybe even spot a platypus or koala and, if good fortune is on our side, perhaps a Lyrebird.

Leaving the War Memorial we head down to Lake Burley Griffin, passing many of the national institutions, Parliament House, and the National Gallery's Sculpture Garden and James Turrell's Skyspace.

We stop for a bite to eat* at "Snapper - on the Lake", an outdoor eatery popular with Canberra locals.
